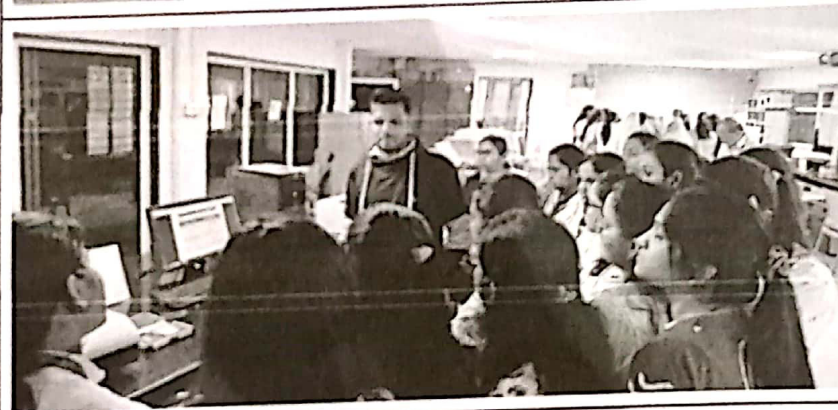

| Objectives | The visit aimed to familiarize final year B. Pharm students with advanced analytical and characterization techniques available at the CFC-SAIF-DST Centre, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. It provided exposure to modern scientific facilities, encouraged research-oriented thinking, and enhanced understanding of instrumental applications relevant to pharmaceutical sciences and industrial practices. |
| Description | During the visit, students observed sophisticated instruments such as TEM, XPS, Bio-AFM, XRD, Micro-Raman Spectrometer, GCMS-MS, ICP-OES, Vector Network Analyzer, TGA-DTA-DSC, PSA-ZP, NMR, FTIR, Micro Digester and Ultra Centrifuge while interacting with subject experts. Detailed demonstrations highlighted the operational principles, applications in drug analysis, and research relevance. In the Department of Physics they got a demo on the operation of HPLC. The interactive sessions connected theoretical knowledge with practical utility, bridging academic learning and emerging technologies in pharmaceutical analysis |
| Outcomes | The visit enriched students' comprehension of advanced analytical tools, expanding their practical understanding beyond conventional laboratory exposure. It enhanced scientific curiosity, research aptitude, and confidence in using modern instrumentation. Students gained insights into interdisciplinary applications, preparing them for higher studies, industrial roles, and innovative contributions within the pharmaceutical research ecosystem. |
